We got to stay in our house a couple of nights before giving it over to a group of 10 here for the conference. Mary and I stayed in our trailer behind the church, organized breakfast and helped out wherever else we could during the conference. It was a great time of serving others spent with our family and church family.

The Monday after the conference we were off again, this time to Victory Baptist Church in Osawatomie, Kansas to put siding on their building. David and Sharyn Finley had planned out the job and ordered materials. Doug and Margie Brown were there helping as was Pastor Lewallen and some of the men from Victory Baptist Church. While working Mary and I got to stay evenings at her parents, one hour away, so we could spend time with them. The bulk of the job was completed in just over a week with brother Finley staying to finishing up the fascia.
